# Learning Options

- Hybrid and Virtual learning. Once your selection is made, changes cannot be made until the following quarter.
- Hybrid learning will be split into a Cohort A and a Cohort B.
- Cohort A (West & North Villages) will attend in person on Mondays and Wednesdays and virtually on Tuesday and Thursdays.
- <u>Cohort B (South & East Villages)</u> will attend in person on Tuesday and Thursdays and virtually on Mondays and Wednesdays.
- Fridays will be virtual for all students.
- Cohort assignments will be sent out next week based on your preference.
- Hybrid model is first come first serve.
- Virtual Learners will be expected to login to their Google classrooms daily.



### Virtual Learning

- Begins on July 19, 2021
- All students will have a district provided laptop.
- Classes led by district teachers.
- Create a learning space where your children can learn from home.
- ATTENDANCE is extremely important. Support your child by having them login at their designated times.
- Access to virtual "specials"
- Special Education team will work directly with families to schedule required therapies.
- Social and Emotional support to promote student and family well-being.

#### Hybrid Learning

- Begins July 19 2021
- 2 days of in person learning
- 3 days of virtual learning
- Cohort A and Cohort B
- Plastic backpacks are recommended
- Laptops and headphones must be brought to and from school daily
- Masks must be worn
- Students should bring a water bottle
- ATTENDANCE is extremely important
- Social and Emotional support to promote student and family wellbeing
- Specials classes
- Uniforms must be worn when on campus
- Meals will be served in the classroom
- 6 feet apart pending 3 ft apart approval





### **Enrollment**


- Your child needs to be enrolled at their school in order to be enrolled in virtual and or in person classes.

## Changes to look forward to

- Temperature check upon arrival, and before entering any BUSD facility
- Face Masks are required while on campus.

- <u>Students bring water bottles</u> for refill, drinking fountains are closed.
